1. Large area objects with infrastructure:

- the monastery and other buildings on Łysiec (Święty Krzyż) Mountain; Święty Krzyż TV Tower on the top of Łysiec Mountain; the cemetery of Soviet Prisoners of World War II in Bielnik clearing; Satellite Service Centre in Psary; the office buildings of the ŚNP management in Bodzentyn.

2. Asphalt roads and roadsides, sidewalks, cobbled roads:

- the voivodeship road (between Święta Katarzyna and Bodzentyn); the local road (in the protected area of Klonów); the local road (in the protected area of Święty Krzyż); the old asphalt road through the forest in the protected area of Klonów; the cobbled road (in the protected area of Klonów).

3. The bark of single trees at the roads and buildings near the objects listed above.

4. Dirt roads, hiking trails and paths, areas of open soil:

- 7 hiking trails through the ŚNP; a dirt road with areas of open soil being the track of an old railway dated back to World War I (KOZAK 2009); other paths, roads and signs of forestry work are outside the areas of the strict protection.
